The NANC seeks your input on the performance of the NANPA during calendar year 2008. Surveys submitted to the Numbering Oversight Working Group (NOWG) will be analyzed and used to evaluate the NANPA's performance last year. Please note that this is the only direct mechanism available to you by the NANC to provide input before it prepares its final evaluation of NANPA's performance in 2008. Respondents are encouraged to provide written comments with specific examples.

The evaluation report will be reviewed with the NANPA, the FCC and made available to the public upon its approval by the NANC. It will reflect only aggregated responses from service providers and state regulators. Every survey response properly submitted will be provided only to the FCC, the NANC Chair and the NANPA. Other parties requesting to view specific individual responses must receive permission from the FCC.

The final report of the 2008 NANPA Performance Evaluation will be posted on www.nanc-chair.org.

Please note that respondents are asked to submit only one (aggregated) survey per entity (e.g., company, agency, etc.).
